



### **Fact Sheet for Visitation**

**1. When will visitation be allowed at Glen Island Center for Nursing & Rehabilitation for family members?**

Visitation will be allowed at Glen Island Nursing & Rehabilitation tentatively August 31, 2020.

**2. What time are visitation hours?**

Visitation hours will be held by appointment only, between 11am to 5pm, weather permitting.

**3. Who can visit the Facility?**

All visitors must be 18 years of age and older. At this time we cannot allow children to visit the facility to ensure the safety of our residents and the safety of the child.

**4. What do I do when I arrive for my visitation appointment?**

Upon arrival, you will be screened and your temperature will be taken, you will have to sanitize and be escorted to the visitation patio designated area.

**5. How many persons will be allowed to visit with the resident?**

Each resident will have the opportunity to have a maximum of two visitors.

**6. How long are the guests allowed to visit with the resident?**

Visitation will be limited to 30 minutes in order to accommodate multiple families.

**7. How to I set up an appointment for visitation?**

Families can set up appointments by calling our facility at 914-636-2800 and speaking to the Recreation Department.

**8. Will the Facility provided PPE for visitors?**

Yes, Glen Island with provide PPE to all visitors with no additional fee.

**9. Can I embrace my loved one during visitation?**

To comply with social distancing guidelines, we kindly ask for no physical interaction during the visit.

**10. Can I bring food, supplies for my loved ones?**

Yes, supplies and food are accepted for loved ones but we ask that no food be eaten on visits.

**11. Can I be prohibited from visitation?**

Yes, Failure to adhere to facility policy and procedure will result in visitors being removed from facility.
